Mission Aviation Fellowship (MAF)

MAF, who are based in Folkestone, believe nothing should stop people from receiving the love of God and the essentials of life – no matter how remote they are. Their vision is to see 'isolated people physically and spiritually transformed in Christ's name.' They believe that everyone deserves a chance to experience the love of Jesus Christ. They use aviation and technology, because in many places those are the only ways to reach isolated people with Christ's love.

Yorkshire Air Ambulance

The Charity was set up in 2000 and with the addition of the Air Ways Communication Systems, the Yorkshire Air Ambulance has developed into a sophisticated emergency service that provides state-of-the-art emergency medical care throughout Yorkshire.

The swift medical interventions provided by their Air Ambulance crews have a major impact on a patient's chance of survival and subsequent quality of life.

Back in October, as a church we started praying for Ashton who is only 3 years old, was unconscious in hospital and had been diagnosed with ADEM a rare inflammatory condition which affects the brain and spinal cord. Since then, Ashton's condition has improved, but progress is extremely slow and it is likely to take years for any significant progress.
